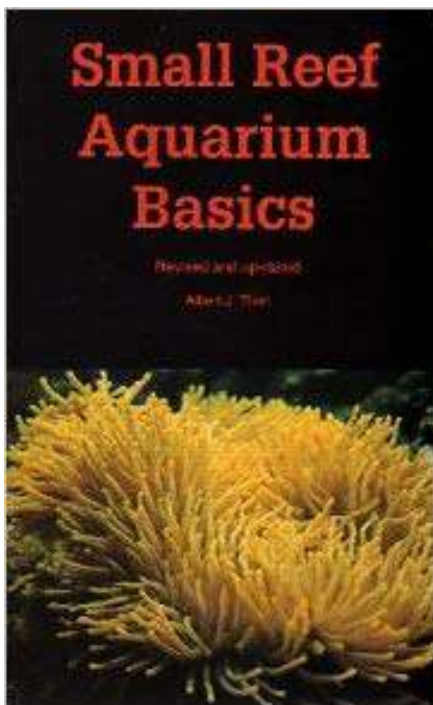

About our August Speaker

JOE STARTED A pursuit of saltwater aquariums in 1977 with a 15 gallon metaframe aquarium. In 1986, he moved up to a 55 gallon aquarium with crushed coral and an "advanced" reverse flow under-gravel filter. A few years later he purchased



Albert J. Thiel's book Small Reef Aquarium Basics that began his quest not just to keep saltwater animals but to create the conditions that allow them to thrive.

Joe left the security of a "real" job after a brief period of raising 2 children with his wife and surgical equipment design and development for Bausch & Lomb to pursue operating a retail sales and service organization around Saltwater.

He and his team have designed and installed saltwater aquarium systems from 5 to 5500 gallons for the last 10 years. He has pioneered the production of live foods for aquarists, developed several food products, and continues to learn how to create more robust systems to make care for saltwater ecosystems easier.

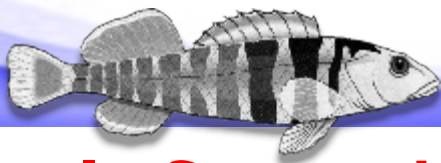

A deposit of \$1.00 for periodicals and pamphlets and \$5.00 for books and videos is required at the time of borrowing, to be refunded when the item is returned on time.

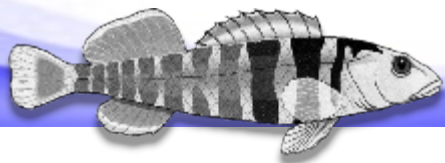
A **"Reference Book"** section, **marked in Blue at right**, will be made available to the membership as needed but these books will not be circulated through the Lending Library.
